BLUE CROSS BLUE SHIELD HEALTHY PLACES GRANT

Parks & Recreation Director Traci Bennett-Hobek presented to the commission and staff a proposal to apply for the Blue Cross Blue Shield Healthy Places Grant, which would be used to build an outdoor fitness court behind the duck pond pavilion. The commission decided to pursue this plan and a resolution will be presented at the next commission meeting for approval.

KEY MANAGER/STAFF REPORTS
