PARKS AND RECREATION SURVEY

Parks & Recreation Director Traci Bennett-Hobek discussed the Parks and Recreation Survey for the City of Collegedale, which was compiled by The University of Tennessee at Chattanooga Outdoor Recreation Class, led by Dr. Andrew Bailey. It is available at the Parks and Recreation website through the end of October, 2018. The data results will be available in December, 2018.

KEY MANAGER/STAFF REPORTS

Strategic Planning & Economic Development Director Kelly Martin informed the commission and staff that the property that was requested to be annexed by the City of Collegedale, per property owner, has been completed. The topic of future urban growth was also discussed.

Director of Airport Operations Chris Swain informed the commission and staff that two of the three scheduled airport events, which were held in October, were a success and brought in many people from the community. The third event was cancelled due to bad weather.

COMMISSIONER'S COMMENTS

Commissioner Garver stated that the City of Collegedale's 50th Anniversary Celebration was a great success. He also informed the commission and staff that several questions and concerns were discussed between he and the residence of Mulberry Park.

Commissioner White informed the commission and staff about the concern of an Asher Village resident in regards to who is responsible for the up keep of an area located within the subdivision. He also requested that the flag, that was flown over the U.S. Capital building, which was given to the City of Collegedale for the 50th Anniversary, be displayed either at City Hall or The Commons and that Gubernatorial candidate Bill Lee would be at The Commons on October 24, 2018 at 8:30am.

Commissioner Baker requested that names be assigned to the mural at Founder's Hall and then opened a discussion concerning city insurance policy.

Vice-Mayor Johnson and the commission discussed the idea of building a small monument/barrier separating the greenspace and the Veteran's Park as well as a future plan for a multi-use play pad and paved parking area near the greenway area. He also discussed the need for more flashing lights on the City Public Work's trucks due to safety concerns.

Mayor Lamb invited the Key Managers to the September 9, 2019, Collegedale SDA Church's 55+ Club meeting and also wanted to thank the Public Works department, on behalf of a Bowen Trail resident, for the wonderful landscaping that has been done on their street. She also stated that she was invited and will be attending the Local Government Leadership Program at the UT Institute of Public Service in November, 2018.

Mayor Lamb and City Manager Rogers allowed the students from Collegedale Academy's American Government Class, that were attending the commission workshop, to ask questions of the commission and management.
